

## **ISN-WZ Abstract guidelines for Award /Mini-oral/Case presentation**

### **All practicing Nephrologists**

Abstracts for Free papers or Posters /Mini-oral presentation and Interesting cases

### **Guidelines**

1. Abstracts must be written in English.
2. The Last date for abstract submission is 30 July 2026
3. At least the presenting author MUST REGISTER for the conference, and one of the authors must be a member of the ISN West Zone at the time of presentation.
4. Abstract must include the complete Surname and First name of every author (indicating the presenter and the order of the authors), institution, mobile number and the email address.
5. All co-authors must agree with the results stated and have consented to be included as authors
6. Abstracts should be structured under the following headings. ; a) objectives b) Methods c) Results d) Conclusions
7. Use of standard abbreviations is desirable. Place special/unusual abbreviations in brackets after the full word, the first time it appears.
8. Use numerals to indicate numbers, except to begin sentences.
9. Authors must also indicate if they apply for the following awards – (Dr L.J.Shah award session, Dr Pravina Shah-Mino oral competition). Only one abstract can be submitted per award category. He/She can send different papers to both sessions.
10. The blinded abstracts will be sent to the judges outside the west zone, according to merit, the best 12 papers from the PG will be selected for the Dr L.J. Shah award papers. The next 12 papers will be given for Dr Pravina Shah's Mini-oral presentation.
11. Only original papers will be accepted. It should not have been presented previously in the west zone congress /published in scientific journals (full text).

### **Guidelines for submission**

Cases will be selected based on the following: 1) Completely worked up case 2) Should teach something new 3) Routine case managed in a different manner 4) Take home message and relevance today to day practice

The cases can be of

- 1) General nephrology
- 2) Transplantation & HLA medicine
- 3) Acid-Base Balance
- 4) Electrolyte Disorders
- 5) Genetic disorders
- 6) Dialysis and vascular access
- 7) Glomerulonephritis

All of the above should be no more than 275 words in Word Format with a font of 12. Follow the same guidelines as for abstract submission.
